This month we were able to hand out over 2,000 tracts. Bible John and I handed out 800 in an hour and a half at the Mother Goose parade!

I think of all the places we've ever been, Parkway Plaza Mall has got to be my favorite. This mall is located in the city where I live (El Cajon is just east of San Diego). I was so pleased with the first Saturday we went that I immediately applied for another permit the following week. Many that I spoke with were visibly moved by the gospel. I felt that some were very near becoming a Christian.

On our first trip to Balboa Park Doug shared the gospel with 2 teenage girls. Both said they were active in a youth group in church. Sadly, neither had any idea where they would spend eternity or how to get to heaven. Doug shared the gospel with them and urged them to repent and receive Jesus as Savior and Lord. Both were eager to respond in prayer just a short distance from the fountain. Doug encouraged them to read their Bible and speak with his pastor if they had further questions. I see more and more that many that attend churches have only a fuzzy understanding of the gospel and what it means to be a Christian.

Our ministry is not only one of sharing the gospel with the lost, but encouraging Christians to get serious about their faith.
